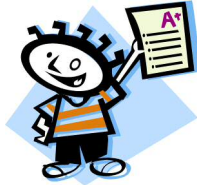

Listed below are some suggestions for donations:

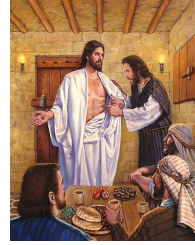
