## **DEVOTION: February 4th, Fifth Sunday of Epiphany:**

Healing takes many forms. The scriptures give us accounts of healing in body, in spirit, in mental health, in community, and in nations. With so many ways, God tends to God’s people; we see that healing is a process and always in process for those who seek God and are known by God’s love.

We don’t have to be perfect to be a healer. We can have faith that healing is the desire of Jesus by seeing how well Jesus performs the healing miracles, but we can also have faith in our own strength to serve through the witness of Simon’s mother-in-law. Henri Nouwen offered the image of Jesus as a wounded healer and invites us into this paradigm for our service. “The great illusion of leadership”, writes Henri Nouwen, “is to think that [one] can be led out of the desert by someone who has never been there” . (*The Wounded Healer: Ministry in Contemporary Society*) What is our role in proclaiming the gospel and in becoming healers in our time and circumstance?

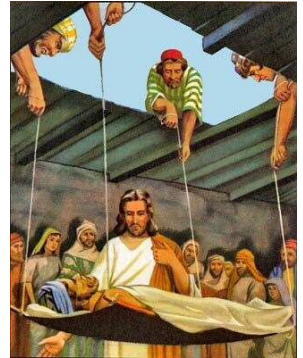
