School Backpacks and Supplies

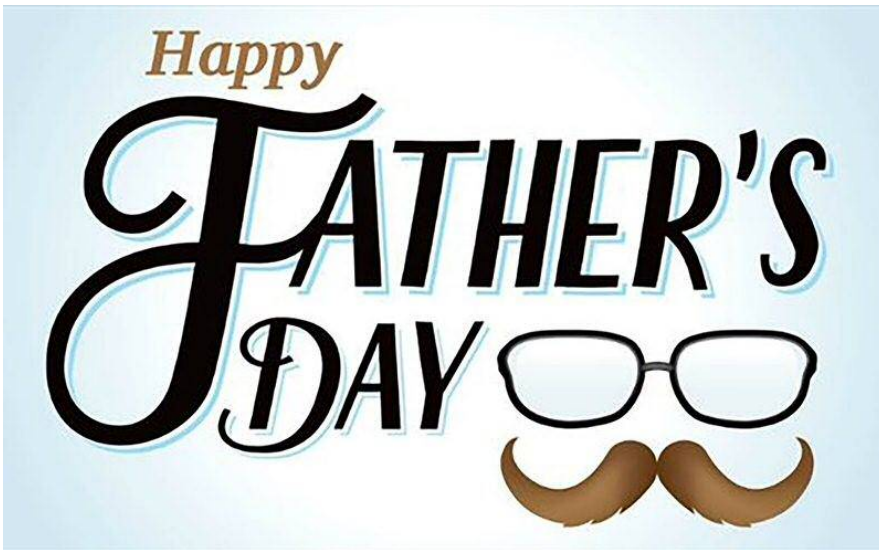
